#### **Brand Hall, UK: (Could this bniour lineage?)**

"A Saxon family lived somewhere by the Great Pool about 3 miles west of Droitwhich. in the 7/8 C. A man called

Hedda moved a half-mile west to clear or use the forest. This is the present day village of Hadley. Around the 12/13 C +/- a Hadley was involved with the brine (salt) pits at Droitwhich, these belonged to monks who by 1230 had built a monastery at Halesowen. (Halesowen Abbey). There is also a Roman road from these pits to Smethwick which must have been at least a useable track even then. A Hadley certainly moved. Was he a mason or a carpenter, some specialist useful to the monks? Due to Oldbury being within Halesowen Parish many buildings in Oldbury were classed as
