**Validity of Birth Certificates?**

Did you know that the sex of a person and the names of their biological parents that appear on their official birth certificates can be changed? In some states, when a child is adopted, the official birth certificate that was issued at birth can later be changed to reflect the names of the adoptive parents in the place reserved for their biological parents – and with no mention the birth certificate had been changed. Now, in some states, even the gender that was determined and indicated on the original birth certificate at the time of birth can be changed. New York State, along with other states, has recently begun allowing individuals to have issued to them a new birth certificate that reflects a different sex for them than was determined and issued at birth.



For those who are doing genealogical research, now and presumably in the future, their research has been made more difficult by these changes.

**Interesting Birth, Marriage and Death Certificates:**

We have found a few interesting birth, marriage, and death certificates as follows:

1. Ralph Hadley died on 02 Apr 1891 in Nashua, NH from “Eclampsy Ecnvnl”
2. Silas Hadley died on 06 Oct 1894 in Laconia, NH from “Phithisis”
3. Mehitable Hadley was born on 23 Sept 1833 in Bow, NH but is listed as not having any parents.
4. Walter L Hadley was born on 01 Dec 1814 in Hancock, NH. His father, James Hadley age 82 and mother, Lavina (Gunn) Hadley, age 80. (Do you think there may be a miracle here?)
5. George Hollis Hadley and Ida H Clark have two marriage certificates for them on file in Gilford, NH. The first listed as 22 Feb 1871 and the second listed as 22 Feb 1872.

## Hadley Room at the Narragansett Historical Society:

As has been reported, the Narragansett Historical Society in Templeton, MA has agreed to create an archival room devoted to documents, memorabilia, family bibles, photographs and other important records and artifacts devoted to the Hadley family stemming from the lineage of George Hadley (ca, 1612 – 1686). This research/storage room is to be environmentally controlled so as to preserve our important documents. These documents will be available to any who have an interest in viewing them and/or doing research on our family. However, we need your financial help to bring this room into reality. There is anticipation the room will cost, at least, \$10,000 to develop. Once completed we hope within the next two years, the Museum will be in a position to start receiving your precious Hadley documents.
