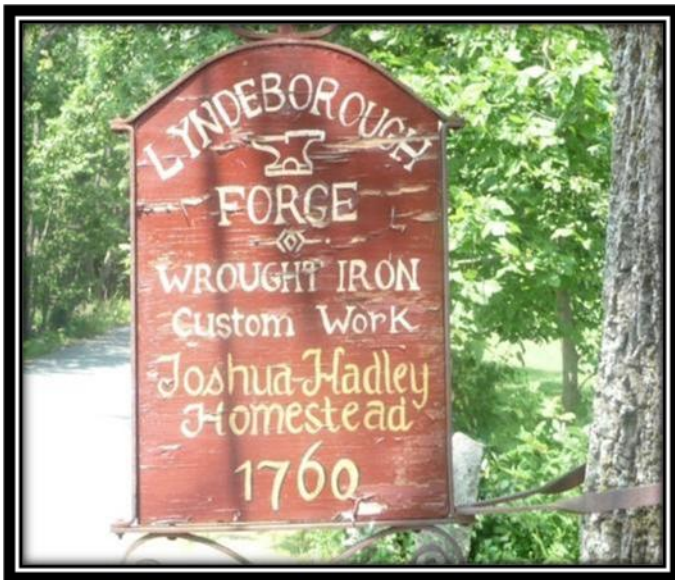

Here are preliminary plans for our
2011 Hadley Reunion . . .

2011 reunion Plans: (Theme: Hadley Pioneers from 1628-1775)

Friday July 15th 2011:

Plans are taking shape for the 2011 Hadley reunion. We have selected Friday July 15th and Saturday July 16th in the Lexington/Concord area of Massachusetts for our Hadley reunion activities. We have already made plans to visit the **National Archives and Records Administration** Waltham, MA office on Friday morning for a 1 ½ hour program. We will have an introduction to their historical and genealogical records along with instruction in research techniques. A limited amount of assisted hands-on research time will be available for those who have an interest.

After the program at the **National Archives and Records Administration Office**, we will have a dutch-treat lunch at an area restaurant and will then travel to the **Minute Man Visitor Center** in Lincoln, MA. This is 7 ½ miles (about 17 minutes) self drive trip. At 1:00 PM (arrive by 12:50) at this visitors center we will see the National Park film “**The Road to Revolution.**” After the film we will be on our own to explore some of the area’s historical battle sites and have an opportunity to visit some of the historical homes. In addition we will be able take the 1 ½ hour paid “**Liberty Ride**” guided trolley tour of the battle areas.

Friday night we will be arranging a dutch-treat dinner at a local restaurant, with lodging at the Bedford Plaza Hotel, Bedford, MA where we have been able to obtain a very special rate of \$69/room which includes a continental breakfast. (Details to follow). We will also have a room at the hotel where we will gather for evening drinks coupled with our social time.

Saturday, July 16th 2011: We will travel the 6 miles from the Bedford Plaza Hotel hotel to the **Trinitarian Congregational Church** at 54 Walden Street Concord, MA for our day’s activities. We expect to have a buffet lunch at the church with an evening buffet dinner back at the Bedford Plaza Hotel, coupled with additional social time. (Details of the Saturday program are under development and will soon be published).
